International Development Committee

The International Development Committee (IDC) promotes the World Federation of Athletic Therapy to other international organizations such as the International Olympic Committee (IOC), Federation Internationale de Medicin Sportive (FIMS), World Health Organization (WHO), United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). It also consults with groups in emerging markets internationally interested in organizing as an ATT profession.

Composition

- Up to seven (7) members respecting geographical representation are appointed to a three year term with an option for renewal for an additional three years.
- A Chair is appointed by the Executive Committee for four-years, renewable once.
- Recommendations for appointment as IDC members shall be made by the IDC for formal ratification by the Executive Committee.
- Submit a report to monthly Executive Committee meetings with updates and progress on conference planning. Will also report at the Annual Members' Meeting. They may be held in person, by telephone or electronically.
- At the discretion of Executive committee, the Chair shall be invited to participate in part or all of its formal meetings

The IDC will:

- Represent the WFATT, the Vision, Mission and strategic goals and opportunities to international organizations that would advance the WFATT Vision and Mission.
- Identify international organizations with whom the WFATT can collaborate to advance the vision and Mission.

- Develop a strategic promotion and communication plan to seek collaborative partnerships with other international organizations.
- Promote mutually beneficial programs and branding opportunities
- Work collaboratively with the other WFATT committees regarding International branding and collaboration.
- Encourage participation in the Biennial WFATT World Congress.
- Subject to approval by the Executive Committee, the IDC may formulate rules and policies such that it may deem necessary for the effective discharge of its appointed duties.
