Academic Institutions Committee

The Academic Institutions Committee (AIC) is the academic institutions networking arm of the WFATT. The AIC serves as a body of academic institutions offering Athletic Training and Therapy academic programs and members of the WFATT. This may include collaborative networking, exchange programs, and research opportunities. It is also a resource to the Executive Committee and works collaboratively with other WFATT committees.

Composition

- Up to seven (7) members respecting geographical representation are appointed to a three year term with an option for renewal for an additional three years.
- A Chair is appointed by the Executive Committee for four-years, renewable once.
- Recommendations for appointment as AIC members shall be made by the AIC for formal ratification by the Executive Committee.
- Submit a report to monthly Executive Committee meetings with updates and progress on conference planning. Will also report at the Annual Members' Meeting. They may be held in person, by telephone or electronically.
- At the discretion of Executive committee, the Chair shall be invited to participate in part or all of its formal meetings.

The AIC will:

- Advise the executive Committee on programs and opportunities that will promote collaboration between member academic institutions
- Serve as a contact point for current and potential member academic institutions which may include being a soundboard/advisory panel.

- Facilitate, promote and contribute to communications vehicles as developed by the Marketing and Promotions Committee (twitter, facebook, Instagram, linkedin etc)
- Work collaboratively with the other WFATT committees regarding International branding and collaboration
- Promote international discussions to foster international student and faculty exchange programs, including the development of a minimum of one webinar per year focusing on content for member academic institutions.
- Encourage academic institution participation in the Biennial WFATT World Congress.
- Subject to approval by the Executive Committee, the AIC may formulate rules and policies such that it may deem necessary for the effective discharge of its appointed duties.
